Elektron Machinedrum SPS-1 UserWave Software Editor

Machinedrum Editor is a program, written on MaxMSP, which controls almost all parameters of Elektron Machinedrum SPS-1 UW beatbox.

At this moment it has these features:

- assigning any machine (including MIDI, Control 8 and ROM/RAM) to any track
- every machine has its own UI
- controls machine, track effect and routing parameters with feedback (you turn knobs in MD - they turns in editor too)
- controls master FX with feedback
- controls LFOs with feedback
- hardware output routing for any track
- MIDI THRU MODE (if you want to control MD with external controller - just select input port, to which it connected)
- track trig and mute
- intelligent parameters randomizer with three algorithms
- up to 10 patch variations
- saves patch in XML format
- patch genetics - mutate your parameters

Machinedrum Editor is a standalone program for Windows XP.

Download Machinedrum Editor and extract it.

Go to <http://www.cycling74.com/downloads/maxmsp> and download MaxMSP Runtime Environment for Mac

Install it.

Launch MaxMSP Runtime and try to open .MXF file, which you extracted from Editor archive.

I think it will work :-D

And yes its work with SPS-1 (non UW version) :-D

Hello Friends,

You can use the editor with SX3 at the same time! You only need a multi-channel MIDI interface.

I use the Midex8 from Steinberg. First start up the editor and then Cubase. Now you can swop from Cubase to the editor. Put the editor on one monitor and Cubase on the other (if you have two monitors). Play a MD sequence recording in Cubase with the rest of your tracks and edit the MD at the same time.
