Hi EU-hedz,

I figured out some interesting sound design "math" last night while playing around with using the E12 BD retrigger as a sawtooth oscillator. The actual interesting part has more to do with the filter + SRR parameters, but I digress...

If you want to get a vocal-sounding "formant filter" effect out of a synth that only has a normal low-pass filter, you can take advantage of a quirk of sample-rate reduction effects to generate multiple "formant sweeper" through the wonder of aliasing.
