I've uploaded a small set called "Starting Smoothly". Originally "Starting the Year Smoothly", but I left the year out to make it more general.

One bank of patterns + some RAM patterns, optimized to go live right out of the box, at least as far as I know what is necessary therefore (e.g. consistent settings, CTR-8P machines, RAM machines, RAM patterns, you should try decay tweaking in patterns B4 and B5..).

Have fun! :)

If you record a jam, I'm looking forward to hear it ;)

P.S. Unfortunately, some "Broken Kits/Patterns" messages occurred in the C6 software. Please tell me, if something is not working properly, e.g. bank A is not full of patterns. In case a kit is missing, I've saved them twice.
