I just wanted to say it played around with a simple pattern with a bunch of crazy triplet time stutters and it really, really got the notes locked in the groove nicely!
Frack yeah, that was satisfying to try out. I was afeerd it would be klunky.
One thing to be careful with is if the track you're recording into has a swing amount on it, you might be surprised to hear your realtime note timing getting swung. Turn the swing off for that track if you want to hear it exactly as you recorded.
