OT: Having trouble sampling from SRC3 set to main output

Has anyone a more detailed tutorial or instructions on internal sampling to a track recorder from the main outputs using a recorder trig please. I am having difficulty doing this from the instructions in the manual. I am following the manual instructions to the word but the track recorder is still empty when I am finished.

On track 1 and 2 I have a beat playing various samples

On track 3 I am setting up a flex machine.

I am setting TRACK RECORDER 3 to track 3 in that flex machine.

I open up recorder setup and highlight SRC3 and set that to main output, and set RLEN to 16.

I press and Place a recorder trig on the first trig button and press play.

The image of the reel to reel spins around and I hear sound from the main outputs, but there is nothing in the buffer of track recorder 3 when I finish.

Any pointers would be welcome.

Did you hold down the trigger and press the MIDI button to cause SRC3 to be highlighted in the Record Setup Screen?

By default, every trigger looks at A/B. You need to unselect A/B and select SRC 3.

Trips me up a lot when I've been away from the Octatrack for too long.

Yes I done that. SRC3 was highlighted in the Record Setup Screen, but I didn't know you had to unselect A/B seperately. I'll try it later when I get home. Thanks

I got there in the end, with a one shot recorder trig, by pressing function and holding down the trig.
