All of a sudden the loop i had previously created got switched to the new sample i recorded.

I've messed up a few patterns because I didn't understand that sample slots are on project level and not bank level. So, when swithiching banks I replaced the samples in say, FLEX slots 1,2 and 3, and thus messed up my patterns on the other banks.

Now I place samples in the beginning of the slot list when experimenting, and copy them to the end of the list, aand keep in mind that "end of list samples" are never to be tampered with.
