Try the E12 brush snare with it set all the real setting all the way to one side, sounds quite like the 909 snare albeit a bi short.

I just loaded up the 808 kit and it's really good, sounds convincing enough for me anyway!

I'm surprised no one has made a 909 kit yet, I guess the cymbals on the 909 were samples anyway so trying to generate them with the TRX machine might be a pointless exercise but the snare, hand clap and toms should be achievable!
