- -there is currently no midi sequencing functionality no midi machines. Elektron has stated that these features will be implemented in the first guarter of 2011.
- -slice feature for Static machines is not operational yet
- -Flex machines are missing END, RTRG and RTIM parameters

if you own an OT and know there is an issue, please post it here. we'll see if this works.

PLEASE KEEP YOUR REPLIES SHORT SO PEOPLE CAN FIND ANSWERS QUICKLY, and include the OS that you have installed. - no opinions in this thread. known issues only.

Nice one.

- 1. When changing between parts within a bank, it seems to ignore the Level settings within the new part, keeping the new tracks Level at that set by the previous part.. Reload solves the problem. (V. 0.99)

When sampling using triggers under some conditions it can appear the sample is out of sync with other tracks, the solution is to go to the trim screen and move the start point earlier V0.99

Normalising a sample can sometimes lead to clicks being added, the best option (as of V0.99) is to save the sample first, then normalise, then if the sample is corrupted it can be reloaded.

Sometimes when loading in a sample from the CF card the sound can have a slight click on the end, a solution is to go to trim screen and hold function whilst rotating the encoder for END counterclockwise. (V0.99)

The offset parameter is not available in the arranger (V0.99)

The scene parameter does not appear to work in the arranger, scenes can be entered but are not changed during playback. (V0.99)

Additional parameters are in AMP setup, there is no description for these in the manual.

I do have this problem as well. I did "Test mode" and it says "ATA fail". I also did "Empty reset", but this doesn´t effect the Compact flash drive, so it doesn´t seem to solve the problem.

Since then the OT freezes everytime I do something with the Compact flash card via "Projects" (set restore point/change project/save new project/etc.). So I am not able to do much since then. I will try to format my card (original) now and see if that helps.

I rebooted more than once, but it doesnÂ't help.

I think I also know when this happened, so this might be a suggestion to everyone else to be careful about: I did a backup on my computer (intel mac osx 10.5.8) with "super duper" and the OT was connected via USB, but not enabled (System/enable USB Disk) through the OT (ejected on the computer). While I did the backup I saw that the scrolling bar on the OTÂ's display kept going and going and wouldnÂ't stop until the OT froze.

So, it might be a good idea to always disconnect the usb cable from the OT to the computer when not needed, especially when you do things like backups/repair permissions/etc.. I didn´t use leopards timemachine for this specific backup, so I don´t know if this would make a difference.

I will write elektron a bug report, but I thought I let you know, so that everyone is aware that this might cause a problem.:) I hope I will get this working again, because I canÂ't do much if I canÂ't use my drive on the OT anymore.:dry:

Edit: I just did "enable USB disk" on the OT, but the drive doesnÂ't show up on my computer anymore. It feezes the OT as well then. Uuhh, now this is not good. Seems like I am not really able to use my OT for now and wait for a fix.:(

The test is dead simple. All you need to do is...

- 1. Plug your old 'broken' CF card into the OT
- 2. Plug the OT into the Mac and when the drive mounts just open it up once
- 3. Close the finder window and use the software scrag mentions to unmount the drive.
- 4. Test card

If the problem still persist then the card is just plain knackered.

If it seems to work fine then scrag could be correct - to test further, just follow the steps above again but at step 3 don't use the software scrag mentioned, then if the card starts exhibiting this odd behaviour again scrag is most likely right. I should probably stress that I don't suspect that the creation of these files is the cause of the problem experienced by rennweg - I very much doubt it in fact. This thread just just seemed like a good place to mention the Hidden File Cleaner.

The files created by OS X are called .DS\_Store - one is dropped in every folder that you browse. It's a similar concept to Windows' desktop.ini & thumbs.db files. Because the file name starts with a "." they're hidden on a \*NIX file system - like OS X - and don't show up in the finder. They're not so invisible on a FAT32 files system though, and can be seen in the Windows Explorer and, I guess, by the OT OS.

guys
i noticed when i loaded a very short bass drum sample to flex machine that i really can't timestretch it as i please because when i'm in the audio editor menu it always shows the original tempo as: 300 and the trim/loop lenght as some ridiculously tiny value like: 0.02 so when i try to stretch this bastard it always ends up: tempo is 300 and won't go further and the stretch does nothing to the sound even as the menu allows me to put the trim length to 1-20 and so on (from 0.02 there should be a huge difference)
curiously i found out that if i don't trim the bass drum from the original sample then it let's me stretch it to a ridiculous degree but only as a slice of a much longer beat (which, understandably, is detected having an original tempo of 105 or so - so it actually let's me triple the length (from tempo:100 to tempo:300) of the individual slice when i do it manually using the rate (as TSRT) parameter locks.

This thread doesn't seem to be very active, but I didn't want to make a new one, so here it goes:
The amplitude modulation frequency on the Lo-Fi effect acts strangely starting at 0, the frequency increases until you reach 8, which is even slower than 0. Then it gets faster again until you reach 17, where it slows to a speed that seems to be between the 12 & 13 setting. From there it seems to have somewhat erratic behavior. I'm not sure if this was intentional if it is I'd like to know the reasoning behind it.

Updating to 1.02 has fixed the problem, but I'm still getting random crashes Am I the only one finding this machine extremely unstable? I wouldn't be happy to play out with it at the moment, and its been out a year now, so I'd expect it to be a bit better. I was hardly an early adopter								
My latest issue is that when I was slicing up a track (whole track for sampling) the machine froze and I had to reboot it. When I restarted it, it still had all the slice points etc, but somehow seems to be playing each one as a really short glitchy loop? It doesn't do that if I move the level knob when the sample is starting, but I can't work out how to stop this behaviour. I've tried deleting those slice points affected, but when I create a new one in the same spot, it does the same thing:/								
:unsure: Now its doing it to all my wav files when I try to slice them must be user error but I can't work out how to fix it.

Having an odd problem with the OT sequencer. I'm jumping back and forth between two patterns. Messing around with the sample loaded to two different tracks. On both of them, I'm getting music through track 4 as well, though I don't have anything loaded to any of the trigs on track 4. The same sample is loaded to a Flex machine on track 4 as the other two tracks. So if I hit stop and go into grid recording mode on track 4, verifying no trigs are lit, then hit play again, I don't get any sound on track 4. But if I jump to the other pattern with the same stuff loaded, I get the same problem. I can fix it by going into grid recording the same way, but if I then go back to the previous pattern which I had already fixed, the problem is back. I can fix it again, but then going back to the other pattern again, same problem. Not sure if this is a bug or some strange thing I've done, but has anyone ever had this issue? Version 1.03B

i for your information i read the manual and used the search but the solution was not helpfully.

So my problem is:

I cut my samples in Logic, Ableton to 1,2,3 or 4 bars. Export it in a folder and then I put it on the memorycard of the ot.

When I load the samples into one track for example as a flex or stat then its always saying that the BPM of my sample is 113. But actually its 124.

So I went to Audioeditor and made changes to the Attributes in the Originalbpm to fix it, but it isnt working and sounding probably.

What shell or can i do to prevent this problem, or why isnt the Ot acepting my original tempo. Its turning me crazy :blink:

Small Samples like a bassdrum is no problem.

If I record my whole loops then its also working.

It seems like a bug, I thought some of the new trig modes were setting it off for a while but I can't tell what causes it for certain.

All sounds fine now but it won't tomorrow.

Also after 20 minutes of straight loading and reloading(over and over again) I finally got the project file from the sample pack that I bought (because my ot showed up with a cf card full of corrupted files) loaded without it giving me the error message.

I can load samples but there are no scenes or sequences. The bank is empty.

I need to be completely convinced that it's a hardware fuck up to send something back, and i'm not 100% since it responds to the the old elektron colonic.

Anyone have anything similar happen?

Hi guys,

I hope you can help me with some answers to these questions about the Octatrack - thanks a lot - this is the greatest forum ever!

Is it possible to make smooth overdubbing when sampling - like on a looper pedal (or the looper in Ableton Live)?

Does the Octatrack have an "audio-detection" sampling mode (like NI Maschine)? It would be rather useful to me I think ...

Is it possible to quantize the manual live triggering of samples (for example in Slots or Chromatic triggering mode)? On page 13 in the OS1.11B readme file, a new TRIG QUANT track setting is mentioned but it is not that clear to me what it does.

The manual states that "If the Octatrack BPM exceeds 60 the track recorders can sample 64 steps of length." - But what if the BPM is exactly 60? is it then 32 or 64 steps? I have a lot of tracks in 60 BPM:-)

In general, I do ambient live sets in 60-80BPM, and my liverig consists of Ableton Live (with 8 tracks of clips and four tracks of softsynths, and a live-lopper), DSI Tetra, Eventide Timefactor, KP3, a looper pedal and some midikeys/controllers. I plan to use the Octatrack mainly for live-sampling and mangling the audio - also sequencing the Tetra - resampling KP3- and Timefactor-effected Cue-output from the Octatrack and use it as a mixer. Also plan to use the Scene-fader a lot. I am worried that the Octatrack does not have enough tracks though - also, I usually play for 3 hours and have about 30-50 of my songs to mix and match (track 4 of one song to track 1 of another, etc. - and looping clips vary from 4 to 40 bars) - so, GB is an issue - and transitions between songs/tracks.

How does this sound to you guys? Any suggestions/comments?

The looper smooth overdubbing thing hmmm i never got that 100% working it has some limitations here and there but i did get it to work 99.9% usually went wrong with 2much pitching or playing with the rate. so unless its that 00.1% better it can be a bit tricky.
I do not have NI machine but if its something that uses the input audio as a recording trigger then no
