Nanokey isn't pattern-based - it feels more like a DAW - and doesn't have an arpeggiator which is a pretty big omission. iSequence seems promising but has its own quirks that I find confusing (maybe I just don't like step sequencers).

I've had the most fun with the Tenori app, but that seems limited and a bit opaque as well.

If you want a more DAW style app then it's a toss up between NanoStudio and Grageband for me these days. GB is easier to get basic ideas down, but as a result there's less flexibility when it comes to sound programming. But, you can always open it in Logic on the MAc and go from there too. NS is very configurable, but lately I feel that I spend too much time jump through screens trying to do sound design with it.

And it adds a sequencer, drum machine, etc. Animoog is really nice too and has been on sale for \$0.99 at least once since its introduction (when it was also priced at \$0.99). The Moog Filtatron app is fun too.

It doesn't stop there. NanoStudio allows you to use multiple synths simultaneously, each with its own insert effects such as waveshaping, chorus and delay. When you want to go beyond basic oscillators, load up a sample and process it just like a normal synth voice - great for mashing up vocals or even the whole mix.

Please don't tell me that I can sequence all these synths from my OT, one synth per midi channel using that coremidi thingy, please don't tell me that or I'm bound to buy an ipad this week end :(
