Basically there should be no single digits with hex, eg. 1 should be input as 01. Was working on midi strings for the fx section of the MD to kinda do the midi command thing but no matter what combinations I tried nothing worked. The research I did at the time suggested election machines responded to midi strings in a different order to what's considered the norm, omitted the manufacturers I'd or something?
Can anyone on here give me a example of a working midi string for the MD? Only need one, be able to figure all the others out from that. If not I'll drop Daniel an email & see what he has to say.

The cool thing is that the CC values can be opposite values too so you get a crossfader effect! Pseen - Don't really use a generic template on the bitstream as different tracks require different things, at least for me anyway. It's very easy to do tho if that's what you want. Just ref the CC chart with the bitstream config software. Use tab 'User & Mackie & Logic'. Change user defined to whatever CC you want. Now under channel it will say bs3x channel but won't allow you to change it! Go to Midi Channel position N & change this from 1 to 0. Now you can input the desired midi channel :-) Updated CC Chart here with some basic sysex strings. Hi,

Just bought a Bitstream for Euro 150,-:)

When I read the specs I knew it was an overlooked piece of awesomeness. You'll have to dive in, but then it will do anything you want. I'm still searching how to combine the OT, A4 and MD with it though. I have to detrmine which parameters are best to control from the Bitstream and which will be controlled from the machines. Right now I control the volumes of the A4 with the sliders. I control the 4 tracks with the 4 rows of knobs (F1, F2, AF, DF, LFOsp, LFOdepth, RVRB, DLAY). I use the crossfader, ribbon and Joystick for some of the performance macro's of the A4.

I'm also thinking of a group to control all parameters of my Shruti-1.

Any thoughts about this?
