He feeds the same sound back on itself through an external (im assuming) compressor. Like sending into a compresso from an aux back into a track/channel (parallel) and creating a loop by the sending that through the same aux (into the compressor) and at some point catching the audio That's how I perceived it We where discussing his older gear though which is much harder than now.
