Just wanted to share that I have just about finalized the design for a set of two tier Elektron Cheeks (bottom row will need a slightly different angle). I have had these on the back burner for a while, but have been getting enough inquires that I made time to make a test set - PLUS, it makes them a huge space saver on my studio desk. I actually bought an IKEA RAST to put my monitor on, and the Elektrons will live underneath. Even more space is now regained!

The following pics are from the test version, but the final set will be a thicker acrylic (1/4") and, possibly, even metal. Surprisingly, the test set was really, really sturdy - even at only 1/8" thick. Besides for looks, the sides are designed to help with weight distribution. There is plenty of room for connecting cables between the two sets.

I am also working on a set of cheeks to make any molded ear rackmount gear become a desktop unit... That's later.

Not sure of price exactly yet - i can at least say they will not double the price of a single set (in acrylic). Still have to get pricing on metal versions, depending on demand.

Metal has since been scrapped. I realized that metal would still require some sort of rubber bottom as to not scratch the surface they were on, and to help any potential sliding. The acrylic is great as-is and I can make these on my own - no need to for external manufacturing which would cause them to be even more expensive. I can still look into aluminum, but be prepared to pay for it.

No - these cannot be used with other gear. They were designed for ELEKTRON boxes only. Modifications can be done at your own risk. They use the holes that the Elektron boxes would use for their rack kits - so you couldn't have the rack kit AND the cheeks on at the same time.
