Thanks for that offer, I use a PC for my sonic battlestation.

Thus far i use the A4 as the hub of the tone creation. I chain two of my mono-synths into a moogerfooger clusterfux and stereo out into the A4. It's mainly feedback waveforms with heavy mod on envelopes and slight pitch drifts.

I get a big kick out of the reverb on the unit and I find it glues together the different elements in a fun way.

this last effort was the first time I was using a Euro module for one of the mono-synths in the chain. Without knowing fully what I was patching, the Cloud Generator quickly found an interesting place with multiple tonal elements dancing around in ways that seemed unique to what I've used thus far.

I'm yet to use CV out on the A4 but hope to begin experimenting with that soon.
