Yes, I use the MPC as the "heart" of my setup. I use the Nord G2 as my master keyboard and run it through the MPC. Midi out A of the MPC goes to the Monomachine, midi out B goes to the MD. The Monomachine midi out is connected to all my other synths (Nord, Shruthi and QY-70). This means I can use both the MPC sequencer AND the Monomachine step sequencer to run my synths (even at the same time if I want). I like to program some parts with the step sequencer and record other parts live in the MPC sequencer. Best of both worlds. The MPC also acts as master clock. Only downside to this is that the tempo on the Mono and the MD constantly fluctuates ever so slightly. This fluctuation causes glitches in the tempo synced delays on both the Mono and the MD. It can be a bit annoying some times. It's not because the clock from the MPC isn't stable enough. I've tried using the MD as master for the Mono and vice versa with exactly the same results. The MD and Mono seems to have a unreliable way of calculating the tempo from the external clock - it's too sensitive for it's own good. :dry:

One (big) advantage of having a table like this is that you can hide the hundreds of cables inside the table. I don't like too much of a mess in my studio.
