I suggest the rules look something like this:

SidStation Science Lab #1 - osc: triangle.

Programming:

- * Make one table patch using only the triangle oscillator.
- * You're allowed to use all 65 steps and all three channels.
- * All internal effects are allowed.
- * DC knobs 1-4 cannot control oscillator type.

Recording:

- * Do a live recording of the table, - minimum 1 min long.
- * Trigger with C4 only, - multiple triggering is allowed.
- * You may use all four DC knobs for real time tweaking.
- * No editing of the recording and no external FX allowed.
- * Upload the recording as mp3 and the patch sysex to participate.

What do you guys think, is it doable?
