In order to be able to have my md connected to midi in and out to my pc, and to flick 1 switch to have my md connected to midi in and out to my setup hardware instead.

so i can backup and transfer sample without physically unplugging my md from my other machines.

i opened the TM01 and the midi connections are standard. pin 4 and 5 for current. pin 2 for shield at midi out only.

i plan to get a 4 pole (changeover?) switch and 6 midi sockets in a small plastic enclosure.

i am posting since i am still a bit of a n00b in electronic, so do you guys see any reason why my idea should not work ?
