I'm putting together a program on my Kenton Control to allow me to have much more immediate and fluid access to program parameters (LF filt. freq.; resonance; HP filter freq.; 2 or 4 pole filter; feedback freq.; feedback level; grunge on and off; delay time, level, feedback for delays 1 and 2; output hack; and probably distortion). I'm about half done, and the results are already pretty impressive...I can finally manipulate the LP filter and resonance simultaneously and, more importantly, smooooooooothly.

The control freak really is an amazing and versatile MIDI tool...

Just throwing this out there who happens to own this combo (or one or the other, just to entice you :-D)
