I used the Acidlab Bassline as well for this, as I'm selling it tomorrow and wanted one last piece with the lovely 303 sound. Making this almost makes me regret selling, but I DO need those monitors, and I can get a x0x the next time around for the same price;)

SO, since the focus is supposed to be the Machinedrum, I did some cool routing, sending the Acidlab to two input machines, each with individual and different settings for filter, reverb, etc, makes for some really cool sounds, like the odd slides in the intro, that is caused by fluctuation in the volume from the acidlab (due to the accent) causing the input machine to only almost trigger, which is really cool:) (the slides heard in the intro isn't from the acidlab itself)
